Opening:

The regular board meeting of the Cheyenne Field Archers was called to order at 7: 50 pm on August 6th, 2012 at the Cheyenne Field Archers Office. The first portion of meeting was spent unloading the trailers from Bow Hunters Weekend.

Present:

A. Approval of Minutes & Treasurer's Report

Monica Mallon said that she hadn't time to prepare the treasurer's report as BHW was Saturday and yesterday. Some preliminary numbers were \$457.00 on the raffles.

Membership Report-currently there are 202 members compared to 208 from last year.

B. Old Business.

Orientation-Mandatory orientation for new members has given by Dan Conrad. There were two new single memberships, one family, one renewal and one associate membership signed up tonight.

Parks & Recreation Outdoor Adventures Program –two days, July 12th & 13th, 8:00 am – 3:00 pm. Bob & Mary Jo Day, Mary & Al Tharp, Monica & Jim Mallon participated in this program. Mary Tharp reported that all day for two days is too long, we lost ½ the kids by 10:30 on the first day and they got rowdy while we were helping the other kids. We need to shorten the time for next year to 4 hours each group.

Bow Hunters Weekend (BHW)

- i. Food Vendor-the Jairell's from Laramie provided lunch for the volunteers setting up the course. They turned around the money they would have gotten from the club and purchased raffle tickets to support CFA.
- ii. B.O.W.-Michelle Anderson setup a table for B.O.W. Memberships.
