Minutes from 02/11/2019

Meeting called to order at 7:01 PM by President David Hays.

- We have 155 current members. **IF YOU HAVEN'T RENEWED, YOUR DOOR CARD IS DEACTIVATED.**
- There was an extended discussion about the recent WSAA Vegas shoot at CFA, regarding what WSAA requires and re-imburement. WSAA wants to have indoor Vegas & NFAA sectional at CFA annually. Neal Perkins volunteered to discuss arrangements with WSAA and bring results to next board meeting.
- Upcoming 2nd Leg Triple Crown and volunteers needed. Cleanup at 1 PM Friday; setup at 4 PM. Mat Rusk suggested having a betting Calcutta at the end of the T.C.'s third round next year.
- Connie Crandall, Sec.Treas., said all CFA funds & CDs have been transferred to American Nat'l Bank. Motion to accept treasurer's report was made and accepted. None opposed. Connie is filing paperwork for creating 501 (c3) for CFA Scholarship Foundation.
- Bullseye Archery failed to provide an itemized list when CFA bought BHW targets/cores from them last time. Mike Hoover & Neil suggested buying targets directly from Reinhart as prices won't be much more, however a place will be needed for delivery. Bob Graham offered to provide places.
- Lora Ketterling said dinner has been arranged and donations are coming in for the April 13th Scholarship Dinner & Auction. Donations include a yard swing, eagle embroidered coat and elk quilt for silent auction. Tickets will be available soon. More donations need.
- Neil mentioned that BOW will be having their annual meeting at the Red Lion hotel (old Holiday Inn) on March 23rd and 24th. Meeting at 9 AM, speakers from noon to 4 PM, then a final banquet. CFA donated a cooler.
- Bill Stone, State Co-Coordinator for Wyoming Senior Olympics, discussed having CFA as host facility for archery competition, which is Aug. 9th & 10th. Neil suggested having WSAA provide targets and butts, rather than CFA or State.
- Mat and Mike Hoover said the Sunday night leagues may switch format to 30, 35, 40 yds and 40 cm targets. Possibly also 40, 50, 60 yds for summer. Idea is to increase attendance/money.
- Because of the large cost increase of club house insurance, there was a discussion of whether we need an insurance quote for the conex contents of the container.
- Meeting was adjourned at 8:13 PM.

Senate acts to protect bow owners traveling in national parks

The U.S. Senate passed a bill Tuesday that included language to allow bows and archery equipment to be transported lawfully through national parks.

Included in the Natural Resources Management Act, which the Senate passed 92-8, the bill would provide protections to bow owners as they travel across federal land that many other hunters currently have. The provision is part of a bipartisan effort championed by U.S. Sen. Mike Enzi, R-Wyo., over the last several years.

“If you travel with a bow to go hunting, you should not have to worry that taking a shortcut through a national park could find you in legal jeopardy,” Enzi said in a news release. “It is important that Congress is able to provide common-sense protection for law-abiding citizens who need to travel across national parks to get to the land they intend to bow hunt on.”
