



Use of verifier peeps will be allowed in all classes that allow sights.

Targets:

Max distance: 50 yards

1 arrow scoring: 12 - 10 - 8 - 5

40 unmarked targets each day with a shotgun start on Sunday.

Championship K50y class will only shoot with other K50y class shooters both days.

Young adults will shoot with their competition on Sunday.

Youth and Cubs will shoot all 40 targets Saturday for competition score. (Sunday shoot for fun only.)

FLIGHTING:

Saturday's score is used to determine which flight you shoot in on Sunday. All shooters in a particular flight start out even on Sunday. Sunday scores determine the overall winner each age group/class and flight.

(Cubs and Youth use Saturday scores only)

Adult classes will be awarded with a Gist silversmith belt buckle. Must have at least 3 shooters per class to qualify for buckle. Raffles on site, food is available on site. Novelty shoots Saturday afternoon, look for times.
