A. Approval of Minutes & Treasurer's Report

Minutes presented. Neal Perkins asked about orientation, a note will go out with the membership cards to inform new members that mandatory orientation will be at 6:30pm the first Monday of the month. Motion made to accept minutes by Chad Whaley, Seconded by Mike Lancaster, motion passed. No treasurer's report.
