Trailer Tires

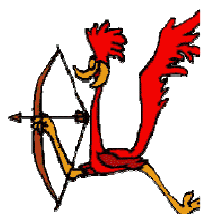
We are in need of new trailer tires and have a possible donation from Fat Boys.

- ** Traditional (TRAD): Recurve/Longbow, no sights, no stabilizer, finger release.
- ** Barebow (BB): No sights, one stabilizer no longer than 12", finger release. (**NO BUCKLE - PAY BACK ONLY**)
- **Bowhunter Freestyle Limited (BHFSL): Reference point(s) cannot be moved on range, no sight magnification, stabilizer no longer than 12", finger release.
- **Bowhunter Freestyle (BHFS): Reference point(s) cannot be moved on range, no sight magnification, no stabilizers longer than 12", mechanical release.
- ** Open
- **Hunter No payback. No awards. Shoot for fun. (\$15.00)
- **Seniors 50+ (Open).
- **Seniors 50+ (TRAD): Recurve/Longbow, no sights, no stabilizer, finger release.

17 years old and under classes:

- ** Young Adult Male and Female (15-17 years old)
- ** Youth Male and Female (12-14 years old)
- ** Cub Male and Female (11 years old and under)

NO CROSSBOWS / RANGEFINDERS

Mandatory bow check max 280 fps 3%error
No chairs, umbrellas, or Arm Supports
Use of verifier peeps will be allowed in all classes that allow sights.

Targets:

- ** 1 arrow, scoring (10-8-5)
- ** 40 unmarked targets each day with a shotgun start on Sunday
- ** Young Adults will shoot with their competition on Sunday
- ** Youth & Cubs will shoot all 40 targets Saturday for competition score. **(Sunday shoot for fun only)**

Flighting:

Saturday's score is used to determine which flight you shoot in on Sunday. All shooters in a particular flight start out even on Sunday. Sunday's score determines overall winner in each age group/class and flight.
(Cubs & Youth Saturday score only)

Novelty Shoots:

There will be several novelty shoots starting Saturday about 3:00 pm. A schedule of events will be posted at the registration table.

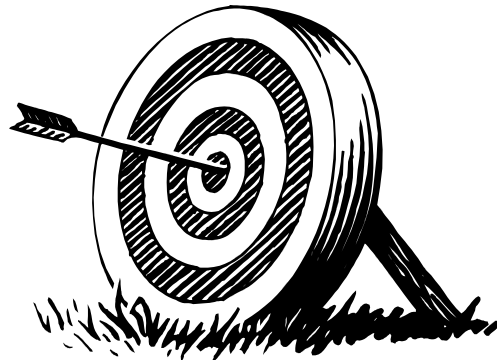
