Minutes CFA Monthly Meeting May 9, 2016

The May board meeting was called to order by President, Dan Conrad at 7:00 p.m. Members present were as follows: Sarah Zacharias, Tim Zacharias, Gary Cox, Daniel Simonson, Jim Mallon, Myron Reed, David Hays, Kent Ketterling, Robert Graham, James Frauendienst, Mike Lancaster, Dan Conrad, Al Tharp, Mary Tharp, and Connie Crandall.

Mary Tharp, Treasurer

- Mary presented the April treasurer's report. The Scholarship Fund account has been set up at the bank as well as an additional savings account as discussed in previous meetings. A total of \$15K was moved from the checking account to the new savings account. The total in the Scholarship Fund is \$2,525.75.
- The tax accountant is reviewing the CFA books to make suggestions on what we could do to make our bookkeeping better. The same accountant will do the year-end audit.

After review of the April treasurer's report, Bob Graham made a motion to accept the report as presented, Tim Zacharias seconded motion; none opposed, motion carried.

Butch Rupert

- Requested update on when the new bow press would be set up in the office for use. Mary Tharp and Mike Lancaster will work on getting the table on the north wall and/or the bookshelves on the east wall cleaned and moved so the press can be set up. – Update – the new bow press has been set up in the office area.
- Butch Rupert's daughter quoted a price on the polo shirts with embroidery at \$15 per shirt rather than the \$30 per shirt we purchased prior. She would charge \$25-\$50 for the digitized images and the club would then own the images. Butch has a catalog with the same shirts and also t-shirts. We will contact Jeremy to see if we can get the images. Update BHW shirts have already been started so we will look changes for next year. Mary will create a new sign-up sheet for additional shirts to get an idea on interest and further discussion will take place at a later date on who we will use for purchase of shirts.
- Butch suggested we spray foam insulation in the target shed and put electric in the shed so we can keep the targets heated in the winter. Suggested we clean the garage and then spray. Al Tharp or Bob Graham will get an estimate on cost. – Update – Al Tharp received an estimate from Moore Insulation for spray in foam insulation. The estimate was approximately \$3000 plus we would need to sheetrock or paint for fire barrier protection. More discussion will follow at a later date.

- RMAA shoot is June 26. Park vendor will have first refusal on food service. Dan Conrad will be meeting with RMAA prior to the shoot.
- Need to level and haul in rock or recycled asphalt, or pave parking lot. Estimates on grading, recycled asphalt, and pavement are being acquired. Update Estimate to do a complete workover of parking including collection pond, culvert, grade, and crushed granite came in at \$26K. All agreed this is not feasible at this time. Tim Zacharias will provide an estimate for recycled asphalt and labor to spread and pack with roller at next meeting. **Update parking lot discussion has been tabled.
- Butch suggested we contact High West Energy to inquire about "yard" lights in the parking lot. –
 Update work order was filed and locate has been completed. Al Tharp will follow-up to see when installation will be completed. ** Update the yard lights have been installed!!

Gary Cox

• The webpage has been converted to a new software. Most of the web pages have been updated with current links and several corrections have been made. If anyone sees anything that needs to be corrected please contact Gary and he will get the corrections completed. The website is looking very nice!! Since Jan 1 the website has received 1740 users with an average of 2-3 pages viewed per use.

• We will have a complete target inventory on 5/25 at 6 pm. Update - Target inventory was completed on May 11 due to Bullseye needing to place order sooner.
