

Cheyenne Field Archers Board Meeting
Meeting Minutes
October 1st, 2012

Opening:

The regular board meeting of the Cheyenne Field Archers was called to order at 7:10 pm on October 1st, 2012 at the Cheyenne Field Archers Office.

Present:

Board members present: Dan Conrad, Mike Hoover, Mike Lancaster, Monica & Jim Mallon, Mary Tharp, Chad Whaley & Jeremy Cooke. Alternate board member Bob Day was present.

A. Approval of Minutes & Treasurer's Report

Monica Mallon stated that the treasurer's report was for three months, July, August and September. Monica stated that she paid the property tax of \$957.00 which was reflected in the report. Chad asked about the phone service and whether we needed the phone in the club at all. Mary said that she believed we needed it for our liability insurance. That there be an emergency phone to call for emergencies. In addition, we need to have a contact number for people to contact us who doesn't have internet access. Bob Day said that they checked to see if there was a '911' only service, but it doesn't exist. We've been told that since we aren't the parties who set up the phone service we can't change it. Monica will call the phone company and explain that if we can't change it, then we will take our business and phone number elsewhere. Mike Hoover moved that we accept the treasurer's report as presented and Chad Whaley seconded it.

Membership Report-currently there are 218 members compared to 228 from last year.

B. Old Business.

- a) **Parks & Recreation Outdoor Adventures Program** –Jim Wollenburg came to present a plaque for the club helping them with the program. Mary Tharp reported that two days for this long is too long, we lost ½ the kids by 10:30 on the first day and they got rowdy while we were helping the other kids. We need to shorten the time for next year to 4 hours each group. Jim Wollenburg thanked us for the feedback.
- b) **Bow Hunters Weekend (BHW)**
 - i. T-shirts-Dan said we may have been overzealous on number of t-shirts ordered. Mary Tharp said we should let the members know that we have t-shirts to sell. There are grey and camo available in most sizes.
- c) **Curt Gowdy Archery Range**-We got all the club's money back from the State of Wyoming.
- d) **Mail Boxes**-Jim Frauendienst got a mailbox from Leaning Tree saving us \$200.00. We will need to get a plexi glass box to have copies of our membership form for non-members to fill out and drop in the mailbox. Dan said the box will need to be attached to the door. It was also decided that someone needs to come out every few days to pick up the forms and money for memberships.
- e) **Old trailer lights**-we need to fix the trailer lights on the old trailer before we use it again.
- f) **Tents**-Mike Hoover took the tent in and had the tears repaired and had them check the grommets for missing ones and ones needing repaired. He will call to see about picking them up.
- g) **Shoots**-WSAA Vegas 450 shoots are not a given, Mary will take them off the schedule.

Trad Shoot/Swap Meet the 1st Saturday in December. Mary Tharp reported that Bob Day and Mel Schlagel will do this shoot. Bob said that he will need someone to help with cleanup on Friday afternoon, he will do the flier, registration 8:30, shoot at 9:30, Free Chili Feed after the shoot, Swap meet @ 1:00 pm. \$20.00 adults, Young Adult- \$15.00 and Hunter class-\$15.00, Youth & Cubs – free.

Shoot for the Girls-October 21st-Since it is a donation event, all shooters are \$20.00 including kids. Mary will get ahold of Lynn Walter to see what we need to do. The shoot will be at 1:00pm. The organization sends targets and score cards, the club did the 1st place trophies. Al and AJ will be in charge of shoot and they will see what they can do at this point for awards. Donations will go to the National Breast Cancer Foundation to support free mammograms, education, support and early detection services. 1 in 8 women will be diagnosed with Breast Cancer in their lifetime.

Christmas Party-December 15th Mary asked if we were going to do the Christmas party this year. Dan said we should, Mary asked if someone would step up to run this event. Dan said everyone should help out with it.

Tuesday night shoots-We need someone to run the Tuesday night shoots.

Thursday night shoots-Monica and Jim Mallon stepped up to run this shoot.

Sunday afternoon shoots-Mike Hoover and Mat Rusk will be running these shoots. They will start October 14th and they will do them at 4:00 pm.

Triple Crown-Mary Tharp reported that she sent the last three vests out to winners and that it cost \$12.00 for mailing, she said that this board needs to help preplan the Triple Crown so the incoming board won't be behind trying to do the 1st leg as soon as they are initiated. Mary asked if we should look at something less personal for awards for the Triple Crown. After discussion, it was decided that winners like the vests or hoodies, but that we need to be getting sizes from the top three winners in the event they win the final award and then we need to try to preplan what we are going to order.

- h) **WSAA**-Mike Hoover said the club needs to get a new rep. There is a meeting in Casper October 13 & 14. discussion was on e-mail from Lynell that said that WSAA may merge with BOW. Mike Hoover said that won't happen. Monica and Mary said that's the way we read the e-mail. Mary said she would forward the e-mail to the board members so they could read it.
- i) **2013 Board Recruitment**-Not all officers or board members will be going on next year. For sure, Mary Tharp will not be going on as secretary. Mary will help the new secretary get trained. Be thinking about being an officer or board member for 2013. This is everyone's club. Step up and help.

D. New Business

No new business was brought up.

Chad Whaley made a motion to adjourn the meeting, Jeremy Cooke seconded the motion. The meeting adjourned at 7:54 p.m.


