Challenges and ideas about how to improve Bowhunters Weekend were discussed at this meeting. Some of the issues raised were as follows:

- Registration Issues- recommendations or ideas on a quicker and more efficient system will be reviewed by the club to replace the old system being used now.
- We are looking into upgrading the bowhunter weekend handicap definitions/brochures in order to be easier to understand.
- We need more people to contribute to setting up/getting involved with the club. The more participation we have, the stronger the community of the club becomes. This also allows for setting up shoots to happen more efficiently. Any ideas for a mass texting platform would be beneficial for the board to review.
- We need better communication on-time starts and shoot times for all participants.
- We would like to work on printing as many of the registration forms prior to the day of the shoot, particularly on Sunday. This allows for a smoother process of checking in.
- We would like to emphasize shooters check their scores more closely, to prevent the club from having to judge over scoring discrepancies.

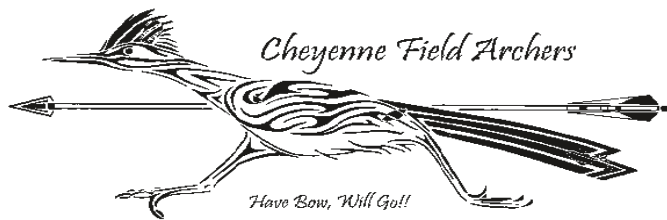
