Annual Board Meeting January 4, 2014

Opening:

The monthly meeting of the Cheyenne Field Archers was called to order at 6:25pm.

A. Approval of Minutes & Treasurer's Report

The minutes of the meeting held on December 2nd were presented. The July's treasurer's report was presented. Dan Conrad asked if anyone had any questions. A Motion was made by to accept the secretary's and treasurer's report. Jeremy Cooke made the motion Jim Mallon seconded it. The motion carried.

A. Old Business:

1) The meeting in Laramie with Game and Fish went well - looks like we will get our archery season back.

2) The award for Archer of the year was purchased.

B. New Business:

1) The 2014 Budget was passed out and went over - Jeremy Cooke made a motion to accept the budget, David Hays made a second and the motion carried.

2) Dan Conrad proposed redoing the floor - it will be looked into and brought up again at the next meeting.

3) There was a proposal that we build a breeze way between the building and the garage. Al Tharp will get a price and have that available at the next meeting.

4) Neal Perkins and Jeremy Cooke volunteered to take over a Public Relations Committee. They will do what they can to increase awareness of our club and our activities.

5) There was a motion made and passed to waive the membership fee for those serving as officers and on the Board. This may not meet with our non-

profit status so the Secretary of States Office will be contacted to check on it.

6) There was a motion made to increase the dues in 2015 by \$25 for singles and families and raise the associate and youth fee to \$35. If you come out and work 5 times per year your membership would revert back to the old price. Since this is a by laws change it will have to be announced twice and then voted on by the membership.

7) The lighting of the building was brought into discussion. Know that fluorescent bulbs may be banned in years to come the thought was to change to LED lighting - there was some discussion and the matter was tabled.

8) It was decided to appoint a rules Committee to come up with the rules that will govern our shoots. The committee includes: Randy Burtis, Mat Rusk, Mike Hoover, and Dan Conrad. They will meet and come back with a proposal.

9) Snap On returned the membership they were given as a Gold Supporter, Jeremy Cooke proposed giving the membership to a family that could use it. It was agreed upon and the membership was given to the Blunn Family.'

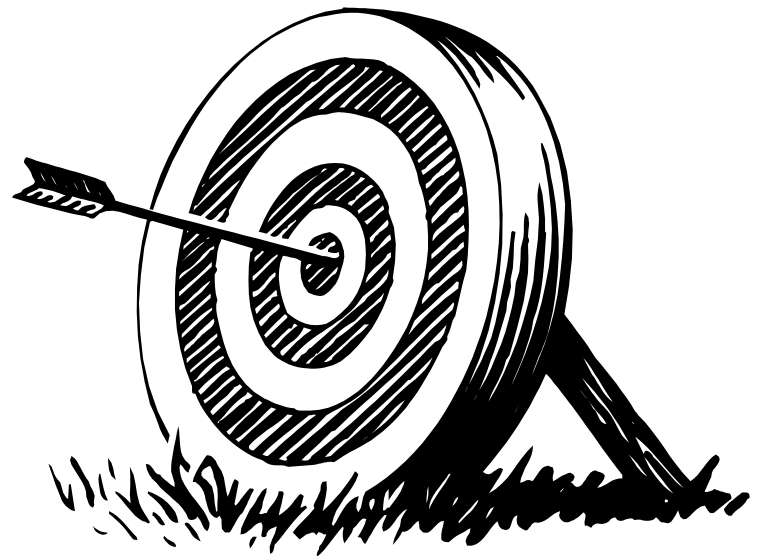
