

## CHEYENNE FIELD ARCHERS SCHOLARSHIP 2019

Cheyenne Field Archers will award one annual scholarship in an amount up to \$1,500.00 to a student graduating from high school or continuing their education in a post high school institution. Additional scholarships will be given based on qualified applications and funds available.

Cheyenne Field Archers is a Not for Profit membership club established in 1954, focused on elevating the sport of archery. It is a community and family oriented organization of over 300 members. The 40 yard indoor range is available to members 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The club hosts 3-D leagues and paper target leagues, as well as the Junior Olympic Archery Development (JOAD) program. Multiple shoots are held throughout the year to raise money for community causes, such as Access Yes. Cheyenne Field Archers also holds an annual Bowhunters' Weekend outdoor shoot and participates in Cheyenne Super Day and the Summer Outdoor Slam.

#### **Eligibility:**

Applicant must be a current member of Cheyenne Field Archers. May have individual membership or be listed as a member on a family membership. If 18 years or older, you must have your own membership. **Membership dues must be current at time of application.** 

Applicant will need to supply proof of registration in a continuing educational program prior to award being distributed.

Although GPA will not be used to rank applicants, a minimum high school GPA of 2.0 will be required to qualify. A transcript will be required as proof of GPA. If already in college or trade school, the GPA must be above 2.0 and a transcript or current progress report is required.

A completed application form must be submitted by April 10, 2019. Please allow sufficient time if mailing. The recipient will be announced on or before April 30, 2019. All applicants will be notified.
